Early call for symposia opening on October 1 and closing on December 1, 2019	<ul> <li>To submit a symposium, you have to identify         <ul> <li>3 oral presentations</li> <li>3 presenters</li> <li>a symposium chair and discussant.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Your symposium presentation must have a common theme. It may consist of 3 thematically connected but distinct projects or one or two projects that include multiple perspectives</li> <li>Length: 75 minutes – with each presentation lasting 15 minutes – leaving 30 minutes for interactivity</li> <li>The role of your chair and discussant will be to summarize, comment and facilitate a discussion amongst presenters and with the audience</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Note that the submission deadline for symposia ends before the deadline for other submissions. Should your symposium submission not be accepted, the single presentations included will be considered for oral presentations.</li> </ul>
Oral presentation  NB!  Regular call for abstracts opening on November 1 and closing on January 19, 2019	<ul> <li>To submit an oral presentation, please plan for a 15 minutes presentation.</li> <li>Should your oral presentation not be accepted, it will be considered for a poster presentation, unless you indicate that this is not necessary.</li> </ul>

Regular call for abstracts opening on November 1 and closing on January 19, 2019	<ul> <li>Posters will be accessible to conference attendees for the duration of the entire conference</li> <li>Poster submissions are welcome from researchers, intermediaries, practitioners and policy makers at all stages of their career</li> </ul>
Submission process	<ul> <li>Please use the RtKW Submission Template for submitting your abstract – provided on our website. Submissions not using this template will not be accepted.</li> <li>All non-symposia submissions will be categorized by theme at the discretion of the planning committee.</li> <li>Only one symposium submission per presenter will be accepted.</li> </ul>
