German-Speaking Implementation Association (INFo-P) (see slides)

- Membership: 136 members on LinkedIn
- Current Activities:
 - Survey on implementation research infrastructure in German-speaking countries
 - ImpleTax project: Developing a taxonomy of German-language terminology
- Upcoming Events:
 - Implementation Café on September 5, 2024 (open to German speakers)

Danish Implementation Network (DIN)

- Leadership: 11 board members, primarily from implementation practice
- Primary Goal: Organizing an annual conference in Danish, with this year's theme focused on "Implementation and Systemic Change."
- Additional Activities: Regular seminars conducted in Danish

UK Implementation Society (UKIS)

- "By way of an update for UKIS we have brought new Trustees on board, and this is helping us to refresh our plans and provide new capacity. We are supporting the programme committee and the social programme for the EIE. We moved from a pay for membership to a free membership which has improved our membership size. The current struggle is in offering product/events given limited resources but there is hope with the infusion of ideas and energy of our new Trustees, including Magda who has joined the call" (Tom Jefford in meeting chat)

Spain/Basque Country Implementation Network

- Focus: Primary care and health promotion
- Recent and Upcoming Events:
 - Hosted an international conference in 2023



- Planning another in-person conference in May 2025, open to international participants
- Network expansion: Efforts underway to broaden the network nationally and into other settings

Implementation Network of Ireland and Northern Ireland

- Membership: 150 members from both public and private sectors
- Recent Activities
 - Secured one-time funding from CES for network secretariat
 - Produced three 20-minute videos on implementation (available on YouTube)
 - Conducted a board discussion on goals and a needs survey
 - Annual Activities: Two network meetings/seminars.

Norwegian Implementation Research Network (NIMP)

- Recent Activities:
 - Hosted the Annual Conference; proceedings to be published by the end of the year
 - Planning webinars in Norwegian
 - Engaged in discussions on Nordic collaboration

- Upcoming Events:
 - Planning a [conference in English in Geneva this September](#) (details available via link)
 - [Two webinars](#) are also planned, with details to be shared through EIC

Portugal

- Nathalie Blackburn is working to establish a Portuguese implementation network
- Currently developing an introductory course on implementation
- Planning a pre-conference session at the European Public Health Conference in Lisbon

Greece

- Katarina Iliopoulou is keen to introduce implementation and behavioural science to Greece
- Exploring ideas from other experienced network founders to start a Greek network

Belgium

- Launch of a Belgian network, currently focused on defining its mission and vision
- The network has 8 members, primarily from Flanders, with plans to expand into the French-speaking regions of Belgium

Netherlands Implementation Collaborative (NIC) (see slides)

- Goals: Strengthening infrastructure for implementation to promote change in Dutch healthcare
- Ongoing activities
 - Website development featuring resources on training and research
 - Creation of a consultation tool
 - Development of an Implementation Science agenda
 - Support: Received a grant from the Ministry of Health and ZonMw for network coordination
 - Future plans: Working towards becoming a financially sustainable independent society, potentially with paid membership

Implementation Science Practitioner Training Programme, Certification, and Intervision from the Netherlands - Gerjanne Vianen and Barbara van der Linden

The new Dutch training programme, which began in November 2023, is designed for 40 fellows and focuses on developing Implementation Science Practitioner competencies as outlined by Metz et al. The programme covers key areas including Implementation Science knowledge, personal and relationship development, and contextual understanding. Participants also engage in implementation projects and Intervision sessions. Upon completion, fellows will have the opportunity to apply for certification through the Netherlands Implementation Collaborative (NIC).

The certification process, organized by NIC, aims to establish a comprehensive database of implementation experts to ensure quality assurance and provide recognition by employers and funders. The certification, which will include Intervision as a component, is expected to be available by mid-2025.

In Belgium, a similar implementation support programme offers 18 months of training for primary care professionals. Gerjanne and Ashley plan to collaborate on this initiative. Comparable training programmes also exist in Germany and Switzerland, and this topic will be further discussed at the European Implementation Event (EIE) in Newcastle.

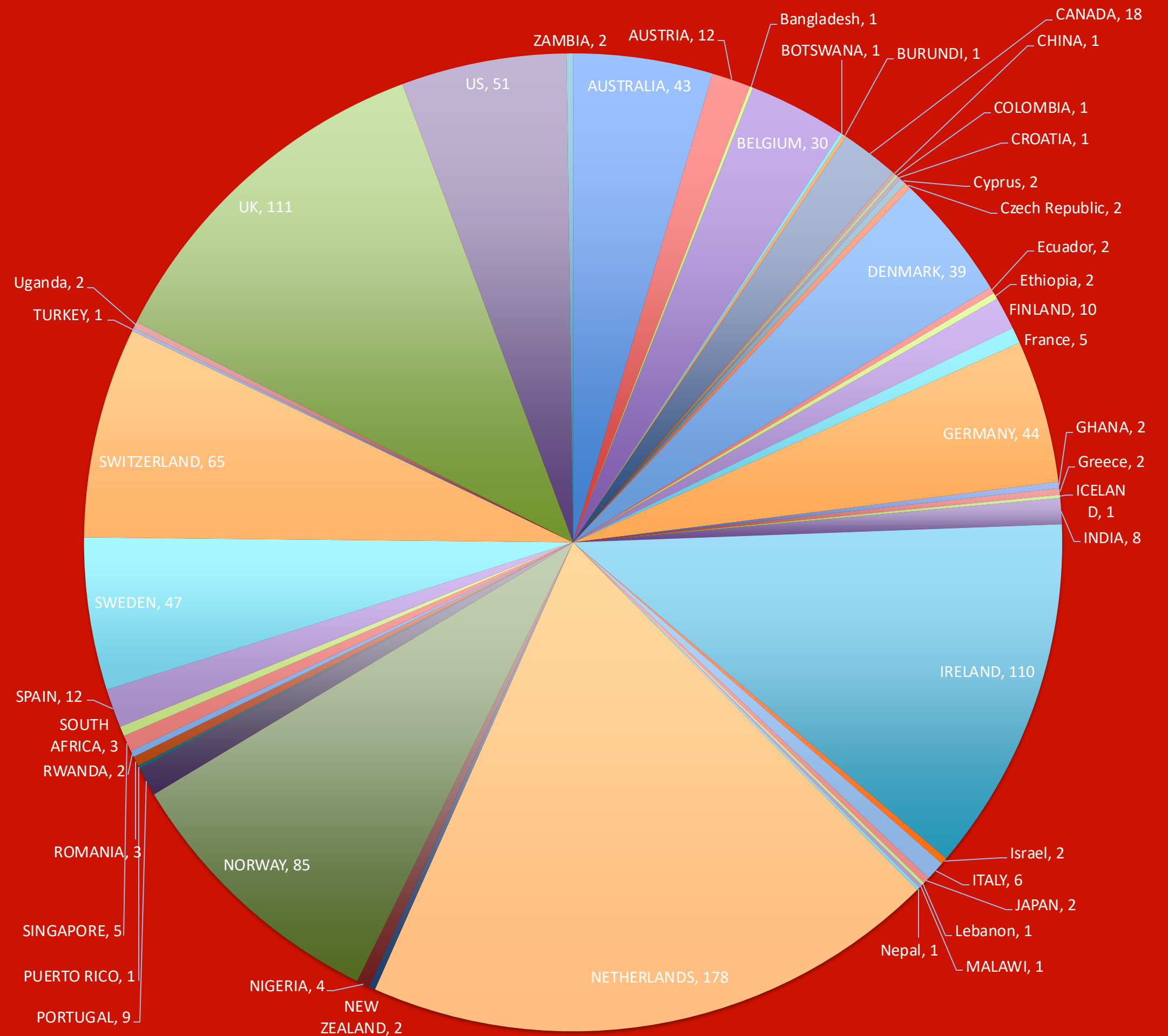

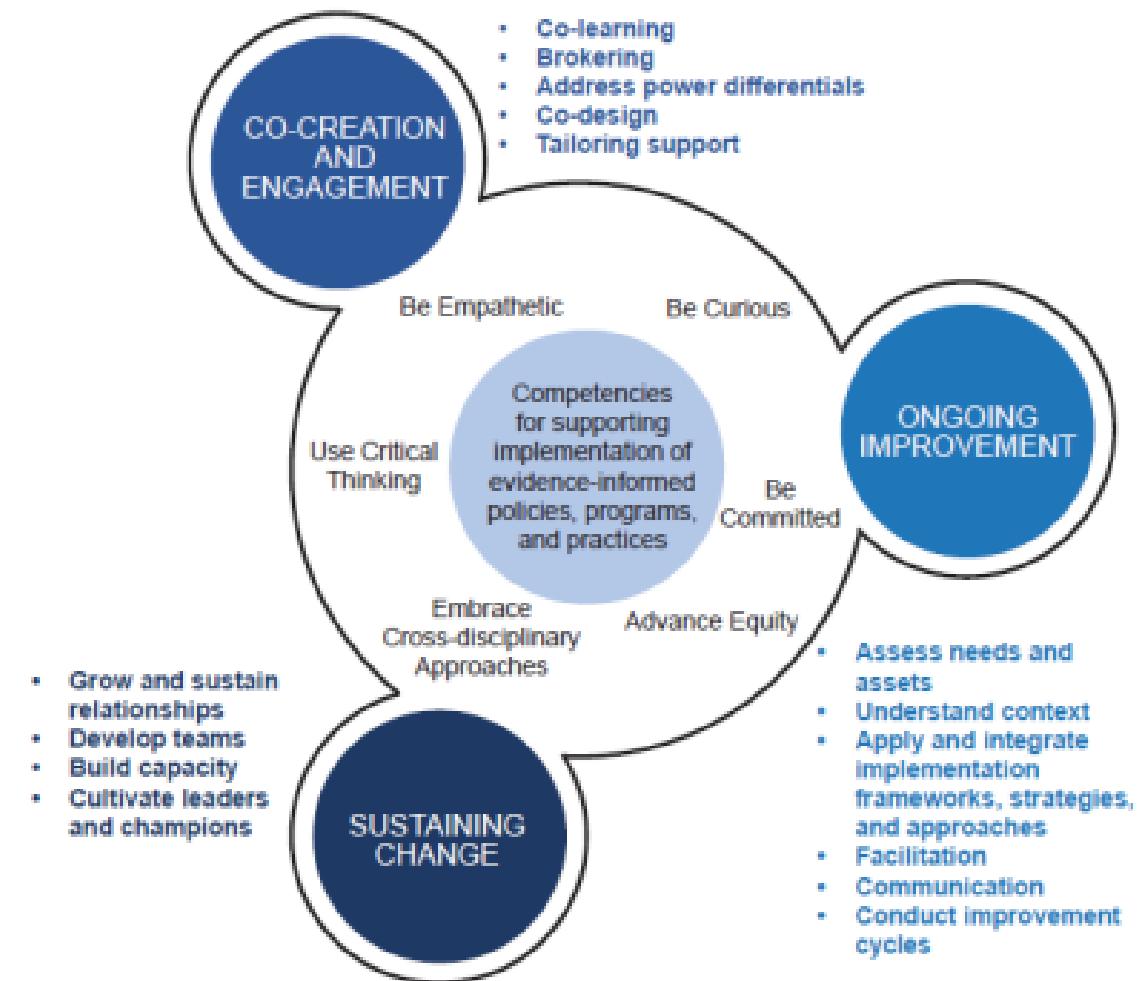

Certification 1/2

- Goal: To achieve certification for implementation experts
 - Overview of implementation experts
 - Quality assurance / improvement
 - Recognition (employers, also for funders)
- Desk research / interviews
 - IMP-expert has both know-how of IMP-science and IMP-practice
 - Keep it simple; make it meaningful
 - Application NIC registration in database, renewal in xx? years
 - Assessment Committee
 - Business model for NIC?? What may it cost?



Certification 2/2

- Criteria / requirements / recommendations: 1 profile (with specialization?)
 - Prior education – Health, Care, Welfare
 - Implementation expertise – training / practice / free space
 - Implementation experience – researcher / project leader / process facilitator, advisor
 - Competencies (leadership, deploying models/frameworks, building a team,...)
 - Products, guidance, portfolio
 - Intersession (recommended for 1st registration; requirement for re-registration)

- ISP Core Competencies Self-Assessment (ISCA-tool, Allison Metz & colleagues)

→ *work in progress*

Intervision:

“a peer-led group reflection method”

“Intervision is a form of guidance in which the participants systematically discuss an input, particularly aimed at the competences of communication, cooperation or professionalism, of one of them”

Common and often required in (health care) professions

Terminology: supervision, coaching, support

Issues:

- Supported or self guided?
- Content driven and/or personal development
- in own setting or independent
- how to organize, monitor and learn?

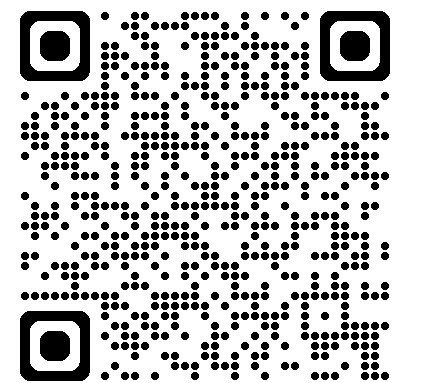

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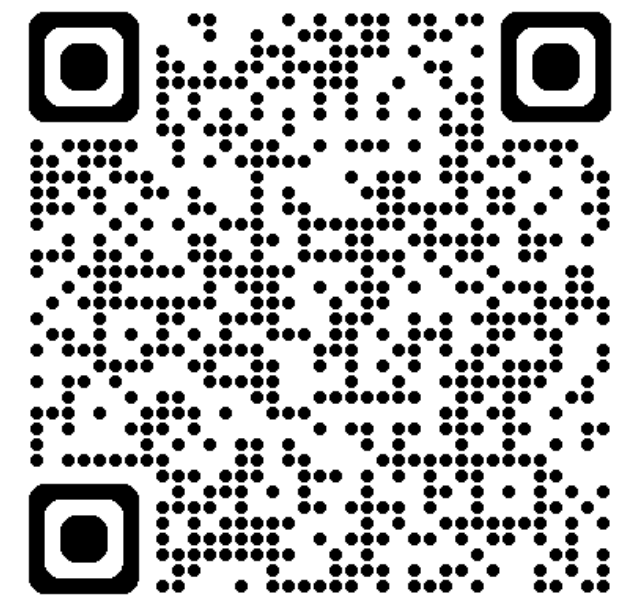
